

## Native American Scholarship Database 2008-09

These scholarships are available specifically for Native American high school students. Students should be encouraged to apply to **ALL** sources of financial aid for which they are eligible. Other Native American scholarships may be available once students are enrolled in a college for a year.

### Common Documentation needed

**CIB:** Certificate of Indian Blood is a document from the tribe showing the fraction of tribal blood for that member or descendant.

**Proof of Tribal Enrollment:** Enrollment number or a letter from the tribe with the tribal enrollment number on it. The letter may also include the CIB.
